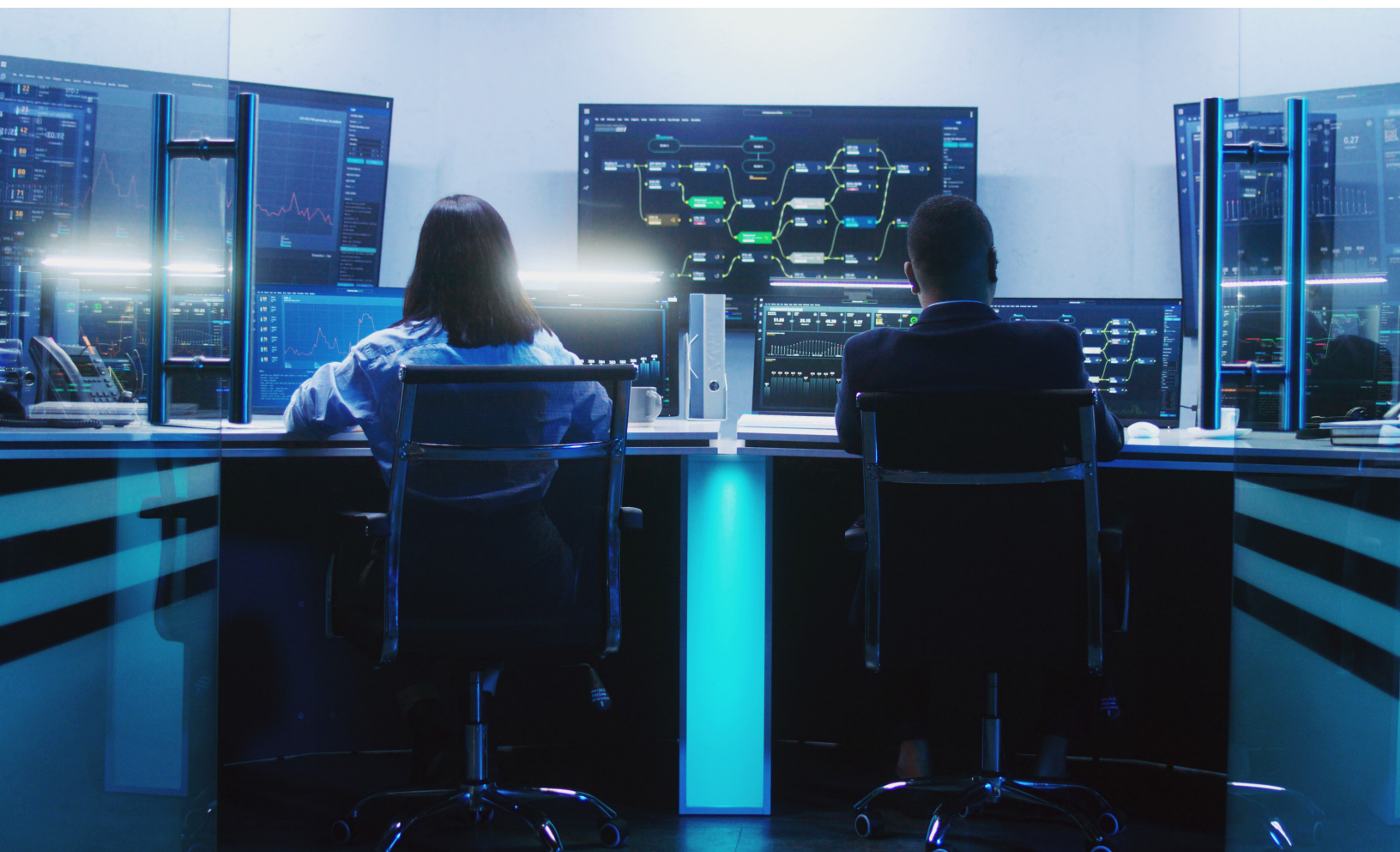
The Challenge

Inversion6 offers cybersecurity risk management and tailor-made security solutions for today's evolving world. Craig Burland, Inversion6 CISO, developed and personally led numerous cyber risk assessments to ensure clients are properly protecting their critical data and systems. But as SaaS has evolved into the operating system of business, his team couldn't scale assessments for SaaS app configuration settings, user access rights, third-party connections, and proactively detect threats.

Without a comprehensive understanding of their current state of SaaS security, Inversion6's clients struggled to remediate immediate concerns, develop mature SaaS security programs, and ensure long-term data and systems protection. In assessment after assessment, Burland noticed more clients

didn't grasp the magnitude of SaaS risks they faced. Requirements

After researching SaaS security options to incorporate into his assessments, Burland believed that a [SaaS security posture management \(SSPM\)](#) tool could provide the context he and clients needed for a clear picture of their SaaS estates.

He, for example, wanted a tool that could report the state of access rights and compare it against a client's stated policy to determine the extent of permissions sprawl.

But a tool alone wouldn't deliver superior value to Inversion6 clients. Burland sought a vendor that could partner with his team during assessments and help forge strong relationships with clients.
