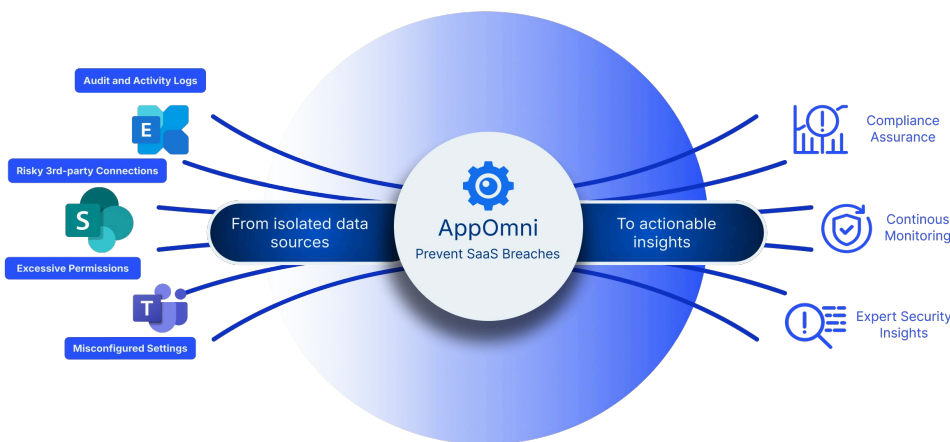

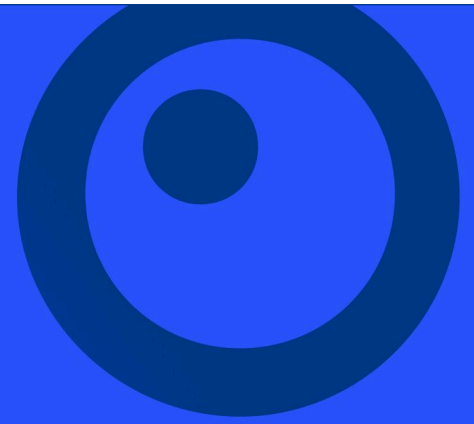

SCuBA	What is SCuBA?	SCuBA, or Secure Cloud Business Applications, is a CISA-driven framework to secure SaaS platforms by establishing baseline security configurations. It targets risks like misconfigurations, unauthorized access, and unmanaged third-party integrations, starting with Microsoft 365.
	What is SCuBAGear?	SCuBAGear is a CISA-designed tool to validate SCuBA baseline configurations. While effective for periodic scans. It requires specific technical expertise to run and maintain on an ongoing basis. It also lacks automation, continuous monitoring, and integration capabilities offered by platforms like AppOmni.
	What is the timeline to comply with SCuBA?	Agencies must align with SCuBA requirements per CISA's Binding Operational Directive (BOD) 25-01 deadlines. These emphasize security baselines, continuous monitoring, and regular reporting, with timelines varying by agency.
	Will SCuBA requirements expand beyond Microsoft M365?	Yes, SCuBA is expected to expand to other platforms like Google Workspace. Agencies should prepare for these changes by adopting flexible and scalable solutions like AppOmni.
